EYE2023 Quiz Tournament



Tournament Regulations

Hello and welcome to the EYE Quiz Tournament!

The **EYE Quiz Tournament** is an online competition where you and your teammates will challenge yourself about your knowledge of the European Union!

We are really happy and we can't wait to get started with the tournament!

1. Requirements

- A **stable** Internet connection;
- A **Discord** account. We will give you the link to the EucaOnTwitch server, you will
 need to join the "**VoiceChannel**" with the name of your match and wait for your
 match! (It is very important to <u>not</u> disconnect the CAMERA anytime during the
 matches)
- A Twitch account to follow us on "EucAontwitch"!
- A together.eu account





2. Structure of the Tournament

- The Tournament is structured in 5 online Qualification Rounds and 1 in-person
 Final Round during the EYE2023 in Strasbourg.
- In the 5 online Qualification Round, two teams will face each other in each
 match. Only one team per match will pass to the next round, except for the 5th
 Round, where two teams will pass to the Final Round in Strasbourg.

3. How Points are assigned.

TWO SIMPLE RULES: The team who answers the fastest correctly gets more points. The team with more points at the end of the match wins and passes to the following round.

4. How to Prepare for the Tournament

- Download the app **Action Bound** on your smartphone to train and increase your chances of winning the Tournament!
- Go on "**EUchangemakers**" Instagram Account, remember to follow us (**) and click on the **link in bio!** Choose one of the topics you want to train on and select one of our quizzes: begin your training and improve your chances to win!
- The questions available on Action Bound will be the same questions used for the Tournament.





- 5. How to get ready for the Match.
- Set yourselves in a **quiet and calm room**.
- Only one laptop is allowed in the room, and you should sit at a reasonable
 distance from the laptop to allow the camera to see you but not to be able to
 touch the computer.
- Remember that during matches, it is **forbidden** to use the internet in order to look for the correct answers to the questions! Only **one mobile phone will be allowed** for each team to be able to answer the question by using the programme we will propose you. The mobile phone should be visible at any moment of the match.
- Every team member must be in the same room during the whole session. No one
 else, except team members, can be in the room;
- Check that your equipment is functioning correctly;
- Access to the live show on Twitch (https://www.twitch.tv/eucaontwitch) through our channel on Discord or Telegram (https://t.me/+y0EZa0c5aJk3Mzlk)
- Here the link of our server in Discord: https://discord.gg/QjmwxeQB4x
- We will give you the link with the "EucaOnTwitch" server, you will need to join the "VoiceChannel" with the name of your match and wait for your match to begin!
- Remain in the waiting room until the previous match finishes. It is important that
 your team is there <u>15 minutes before</u> the beginning of your match.
- **Be on time**. Teams who are late for the match will be disqualified.
- Get ready to show your amazing knowledge about the European Union!

6. How to play

- Access to the live show on Twitch;
- Playing sessions take the form of a TV Shows, so a presenter runs all the playing sessions. The presenter will be the referee/competition judge;
- The event presenter will call two teams for each match;
- Each team will introduce itself, the components' names, where they are connected from, and the Team's name.
- REMEMBER! It is <u>impossible to change your team's name</u> during the tournament. The name has to remain the same as the one you signalled during the application.
- Each match will consist of <u>11</u> questions: as soon as the match is on the
 way, the question will appear on the screen. The time limit for each
 question is <u>30</u> seconds.
- After the end of each match, the winning team will be announced.

7. Prize

- 2nd position → Trip to the European Youth Event in Strasbourg on 9-10
 June (transport and accommodation included);
- <u>1st position</u> → Trip to the European Youth Event in Strasbourg on 9-10 June (transport and accommodation included) and 600 Euros!
- Payment arrangements: The 600 euros award for the EQT Champion team
 will be equally divided between the three team members, i.e. 200 euros





for each of you. The monetary prize will be transferred to the **bank** accounts each winning team's participant will communicate us.

• The team that emerges victorious from the Final Round at the EYE 2023 in Strasbourg will win a trip to Brusssels (trip and accomodation covered) where it will be appointed the winner of the EYE Quiz Tournament by the President of the European Parliament!

8. WARNINGS!

- In case of a prolonged unstable connection that makes it impossible to guarantee the normal course of the playing sessions, your team can be disqualified from the EQT!
- A team is properly attending a match if all three members registered through the
 registration form are at the same location and can participate in the streaming
 session through the same camera throughout the whole session.
- If a team shows up without one or two members, it is penalised. The penalty will
 consist of the impossibility of answering one question in the subsequent round for
 each team member missing.
- If the team does not show up at one match, the team is **disqualified** from the competition.

9. Scheduling Rules

 If a team is aware that it cannot attend the match on the date and time indicated by EucA, it will have <u>two</u> days from the date and time the Tournament bracket is communicated to the team via email, to contact EucA and request a





change. The staff will work to identify another date and time to hold the match, consistent with the needs of the other teams.

10. Substitutions

- In any round happening before Round 4 (semifinals), teams can substitute a team member only once in case of need.
- Each substitution carries a **penalty**. A penalty consists of the impossibility of answering one question in the following round.
- The substitute becomes a fully-fledged member of the team.
- To substitute a member, the team must notify EucA staff by email at least one hour before the tournament.

11. Disputes and Complaints

- If a dispute arises between teams or players, a bilateral meeting may be called.
- When consensus is not reached, an external mediator will moderate them up to their resolution.
